Chalk It Up Art Festival

The festival welcomed **29,000** visitors as 55 artists transformed Main Street into a dynamic open-air gallery. Visitors included families from Broken Arrow, Tulsa, and surrounding communities, all contributing to the economic vibrancy of the region.

Tuesdays in the Park

More than **5,000** people gathered in Central Park throughout June for live music, food, family activities, and hands-on art projects led by Arts@302. The series remained completely free, thanks to our community.

Arts@302 Camps & Classes

Nearly **2,000** youth and adults explored new art forms and developed skills, while scholarship requests continue to exceed available funding.

Spotlight Series at the Broken Arrow PAC

More than **3,750** patrons from 36 states and several countries attended performances. Students participated in masterclasses, Q&As, and on-stage experiences with professional artists, bringing world-class events close to home.
